Highlights of Naperville City Council Resolution 19, a resolution authorizing relief from Section 5 (Signs on Commercial and Institutional Property) of Chapter 16 (Signs) of Title 6 (Zoning Ordinance) of the Naperville Municipal Code to Accommodate the Replacement of Nonconforming Pole Signs Located Along the East Ogden Avenue Corridor:

Following removal of the existing pole sign, if a new ground sign will not fit on the subject property, the City will permit a 50% increase in the allowable wall signage that can be installed on the business.

The City also will waive code requirements and:

- Permit a ground sign to be installed on properties that do not have the minimum 100 feet of frontage along Ogden Avenue.
- Allow the maximum area of the ground sign to exceed 45 square feet (up to a maximum size of 65 square feet)
- Permit a ground sign to be located within the required 10-foot setback from Ogden Avenue.
- Permit a ground sign to be located in the required 40-foot setback from the interior property lines.
