




The National Community Survey[™] in Naperville

The NCS[™] for Naperville, IL

- 1st time conducting The NCS
- Survey conducted from July 5th 2023 August 16th 2023
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 3,000 randomly selected households
 - Passcode protected responses
 - 612 total responses received
 - 21% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 675 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Naperville overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 4% margin of error






