- Automotive parts and antifreeze
- Dirt, stone, concrete, rock
- Medical wastes/loose needles
- Swimming pools
- Tires
- Pesticides/insecticides

### Household Hazardous Waste Facility

Residents can drop off their household hazardous waste (HHW) at the Naperville HHW Facility located at 156 Fort Hill Drive, Naperville. The facility is open Saturdays and Sundays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. HHW includes household chemicals, batteries, oil base paint and other hazardous waste. ## Refuse & Yard Waste Collection Program

## Dear Naperville Resident:

The City of Naperville provides a comprehensive waste program designed to reduce materials headed to the landfill and ensure that all waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. Waste Management looks forward to helping Naperville be as clean – and green – as possible in the years ahead.

### Did you know Waste Management offers residents a seasonal yard waste and organics collection cart rental program?

This service provides a convenient way to collect and divert yard and organic food waste from the waste stream and eliminates the need for yard waste stickers.

### COLLECTION DAYS & TIMES

Your waste collection day will remain the same as it currently is, although it's possible the collection time of day may change.

- Please place all refuse and landscape waste at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. the day of collection.
- Carts should be placed with the handle facing away from the road. After collection, all carts should be removed from the curb no later than 7:00 p.m. the evening of your collection day.



### Refuse Containers

Waste Management will collect refuse in approved refuse containers placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection. Residents are encouraged but not required to purchase a residential garbage cart from the City of Naperville. City carts come in 32-, 68-, or 95-gallon sizes and are unrestricted in weight since they can be lifted mechanically by the garbage truck. Carts not purchased from the City must be a maximum of 32 gallons and weigh less than 60 lbs. when filled. ### Refuse Collection Guidelines

- Refuse materials should be placed in a City of Naperville cart or 32-gallon can weighing no more than 60 lbs.
- Additional refuse materials may be placed in bags next to your cart.
- Furniture and appliances are included in the weekly collection.
- Place your waste cart on the opposite side of your driveway from the recycling cart.

### Construction/Remodeling Collection Guidelines

Limited quantities of remodeling or construction materials, such as rolled carpeting, bathroom fixtures, cabinets, wood or drywall will be collected weekly.

- Carpeting must be placed at the curb in rolls measuring no more than 4 feet long and 2 feet wide and weigh no more than 60 lbs. A maximum of 2 rolls of carpeting is allowed per week.
- Construction materials, such as drywall and wood paneling must either be in containers that do not exceed 60 lbs. or tied in bundles measuring no more than 4 feet long and 2 feet wide and weighing less than 60 lbs. A maximum of two 32-gallon cans, 2 bundles or one of each is allowed to be set out for collection per week.
- Additional construction or remodeling materials can be collected by special arrangement and payment by calling Waste Management at (800) 796-9696.

### Yard Waste Collection

Yard and landscape waste as well as bundled small branches will be collected weekly on your regularly scheduled collection day from mid-March through mid-December. If you choose not to sign up for the yard waste cart program through Waste Management, each bag or bundle you put at the curb for collection will require a yard waste sticker. A yard waste sticker must be attached to each bag or bundle placed at the curb for collection.\*

All yard waste (grass clippings, weeds, small branches, twigs and leaves) must be placed in 32-gallon paper yard waste bags that can be purchased locally.

Branches less than 3 inches in diameter will be collected if in bundles measuring no more than 4 feet long and 2 feet wide, tied with biodegradable twine.

Yard waste stickers are required on each bag or bundle. Stickers may be purchased at Naperville hardware and grocery stores or at the Municipal Center in the Finance Department. For a list of local yard waste sticker vendors, please visit [www.naperville.il.us](http://www.naperville.il.us)

*\*The City of Naperville offers residents free bagged yard waste collection from the beginning of November through mid-December. Stickers are not required on bagged yard waste during that time, but stickers still must be placed on bundles of branches.*

### CONVENIENT YARD WASTE/ORGANICS PROGRAM NO STICKERS REQUIRED!

Residents with greater yard waste needs and/or an interest in recycling organics such as food scraps, can rent either a 64-gallon or a 96-gallon yard waste cart for an annual fee in lieu of purchasing Kraft bags and stickers. This yard waste/organics collection program will run concurrently with the City's yard waste season.

Residents choosing to utilize this service can place all of their yard waste in the provided cart as well as their food waste, thereby diverting more waste away from the landfill. Please note: food waste composting will only be available to residents who subscribe to the yard waste cart option to avoid animal pilferage. The 2016 fee to rent a 64-gallon cart is \$109.89 and a 96-gallon cart is \$128.21.
