Field Report for June, 2010:

- Normal landscape maintenance items such as pruning, weeding and watering are in full swing.
- Shelters are currently being repainted.
- Warming House ceiling has to be restained with a lighter color.
- Bridge decks and benches are receiving their summer coat of water sealant.
- 27 Ash Trees have been treated on the Riverwalk for Emerald Ash Borer. This is the second year of treatment

Other point of interest:

- Parks staff recently removed three trees at Brush Hill Park that were infested with Emerald Ash Borer.

I. Call to Order

Havel called the meeting to order at 7:34 a.m.

II. Action Items

A. Open Forum - Members of the Public who wish to address the Committee
No members of the press or public were in attendance.

B. Park District Issues

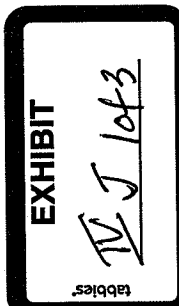
1. DuPage County has installed a zebra mussel monitoring plate near the Riverwalk near of Jefferson Avenue. They will attend to the device.
2. Fredenhagen Park is being used much more frequently by the youth of our community. The Park District has had to de-soap the fountain numerous times this summer. Additionally, the women's restroom in the park has been closed due to electronics problems which should be resolved shortly.
3. The trees that have fallen in the river are normally removed by DuPage County personnel or the City of Naperville.

C. Millennium Wall

The Millennium Wall ad-hoc committee met twice in June to review and discuss the wall's stability issue and possible solutions. Staff will meet with the City Manager later this week to decide on the wording for the July 20, 2010 City Council agenda item. The Riverwalk Foundation has agreed to fund up to \$40,000 for the new plaquing and the Park District has agreed to up to \$20,000 in in-kind service to help offset the cost.

Engineering Resource Associates has completed the pre-final construction documents for the reconstruction of the Millennium Wall. If the project goes out for bid, the plans will be revised and quantities included. ERA will contact Schaeffges Brothers to request a range for the estimated cost of the project.

The lighting will be reduced from three shepherd crook lights to two, eliminating the center location and moving the two on the ends to flank the center section. The two existing up-lights will be replaced with updated fixtures and light bulbs.



Assuming design option A or B is selected, the possibility of using a different veneer was explored.

D. Phase I Rehabilitation: Segment 2

The project is moving slowly due to several factors including the very rainy summer season, a question with the contractor's means and methods for erosion control and the operators and laborers strike.

E. Asset Management Plan

Epp, Havel and Papanos continue to meet regularly to develop the Asset Management Plan. Sections 7 & 8 are finished and the group will begin on Section 6 next. They are currently working on identifying estimated costs for all completed sections.

F. Shoreline near Jaycee Playground

Six test plots have been installed along the shoreline south of the Jaycee Playground; three with woody material, one with only seed, one with only plugs and one utilizing a combination of seeds and plug. With the recent rain all of the seeded areas have most likely been washed away as well as many of the plugs. The woody material looks to be in good shape. The area will continue to be monitored.

G. Fredenhagen Park Display Cases

Havel will request a check from the Riverwalk Foundation for the new glass. He will tweak the drawings prior to construction. The cases should be installed and populated with artifacts by the September 18, 2010 Class Act II concert. The Park District will help with the reconstruction.

H. Jefferson Avenue Bridge Plaza Reconstruction

The project was on schedule for completion around August 27, 2010 prior to the operators and laborers strike. The project is currently on hold.

I. Naperville Riverfront Plaza Project

ERA reported that they are making good progress with the HEC-2 and FEQ modeling for the existing conditions. They will continue to work with Wight & Co.

B. North Central College Gateway Connection

The Riverwalk Foundation is continuing to explore the possibility of partnering with North Central College on the gateway area between Fredenhagen Park and the athletic complex.

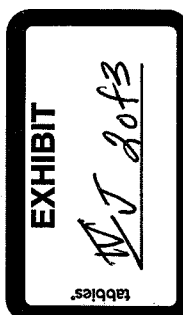
