

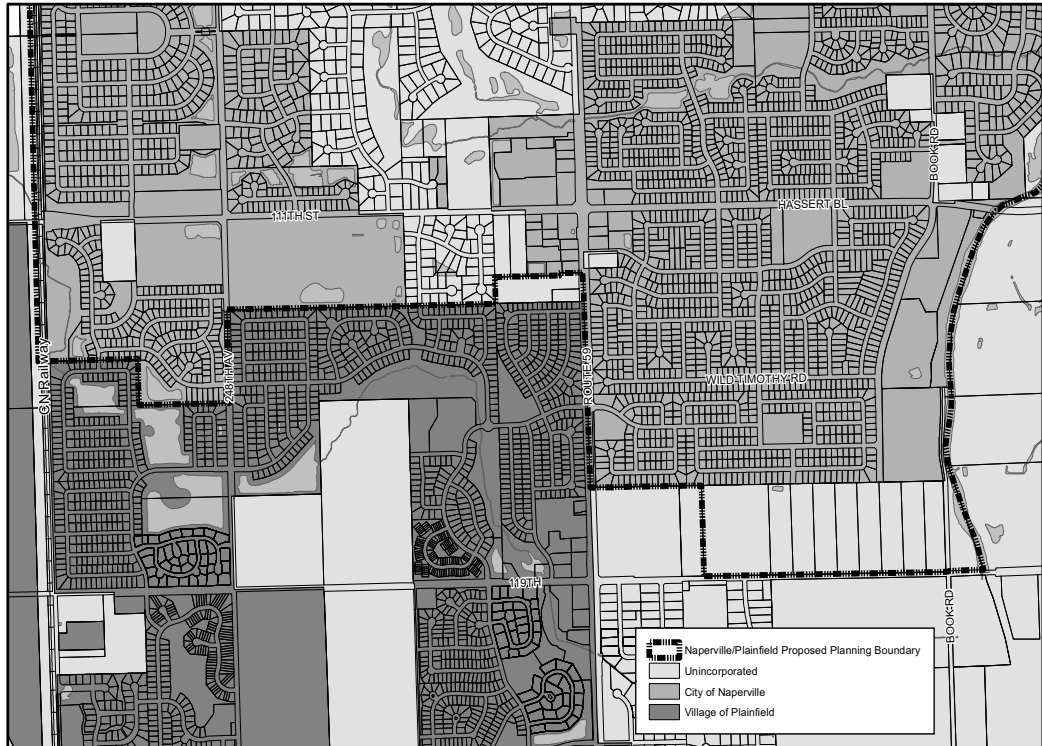
# NOTICE OF PROPOSED BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF PLAINFIELD AND THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given to all interested persons that the Village of Plainfield and the City of Naperville are proposing to enter into a Boundary Agreement establishing a jurisdictional boundary line between their respective entities for the purposes of land use planning, official map purposes, zoning, subdivision control, annexation of property, and other municipal purposes, and providing for certain public improvements.

The proposed Boundary Agreement will be considered by the Naperville City Council, in addition to such other matters as may properly come before the City Council, at a public meeting to be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Naperville Municipal Center located at 400 South Eagle Street, Naperville, Illinois, and at such other City Council meetings to which the matter may be continued.

The proposed Boundary Agreement will be considered by the Plainfield Village Board, in addition to such other matters as may properly come before the Village Board, at a public meeting to be held on Monday, March 18, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Plainfield Village Hall located at 24401 West Lockport Street, Plainfield, Illinois, and at such other Village Board meetings to which the matter may be continued.
