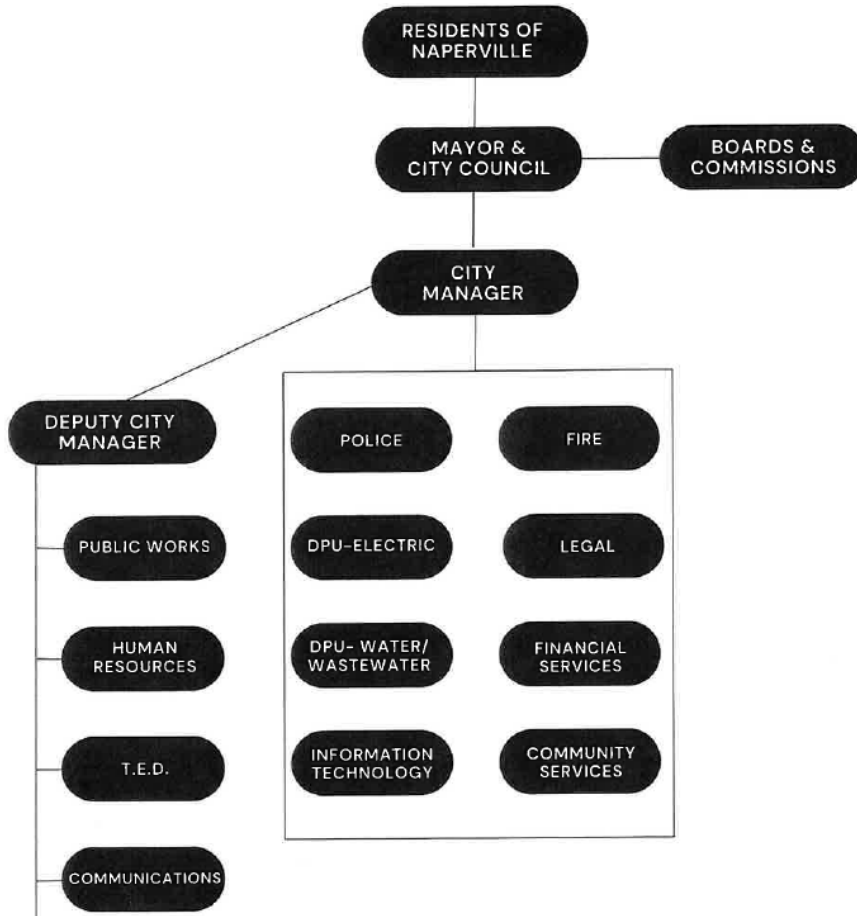

Naperville is governed by the Council-Manager form of government and is a home rule unit of local government under the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois. The Naperville City Council is comprised of a mayor and 8 members elected at-large. In addition, the City has 19 boards and commissions, which serve the City in a variety of advisory capacities.
