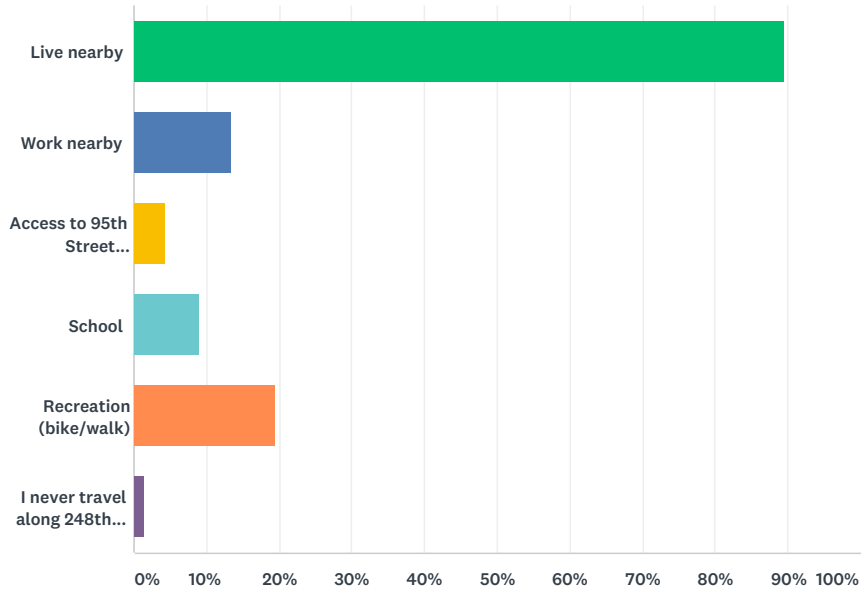


### Q1 Why do you use 248th Avenue? (Please check all that apply.)

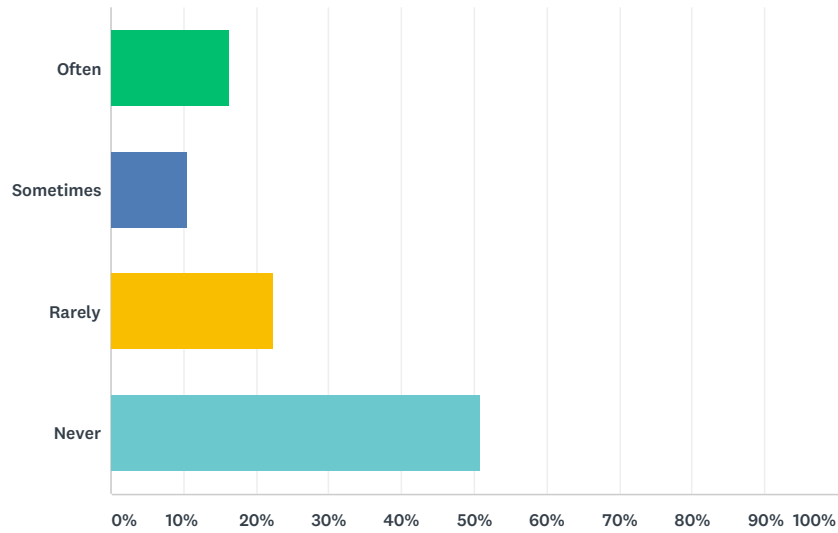

## Q2 Do you ever walk along 248th Avenue?

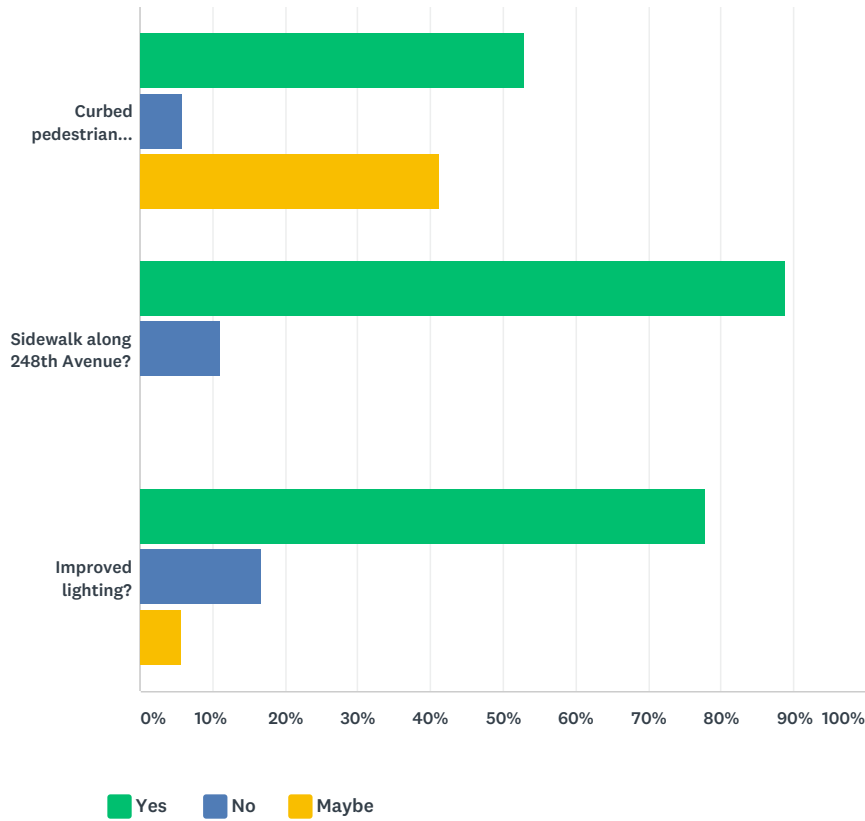

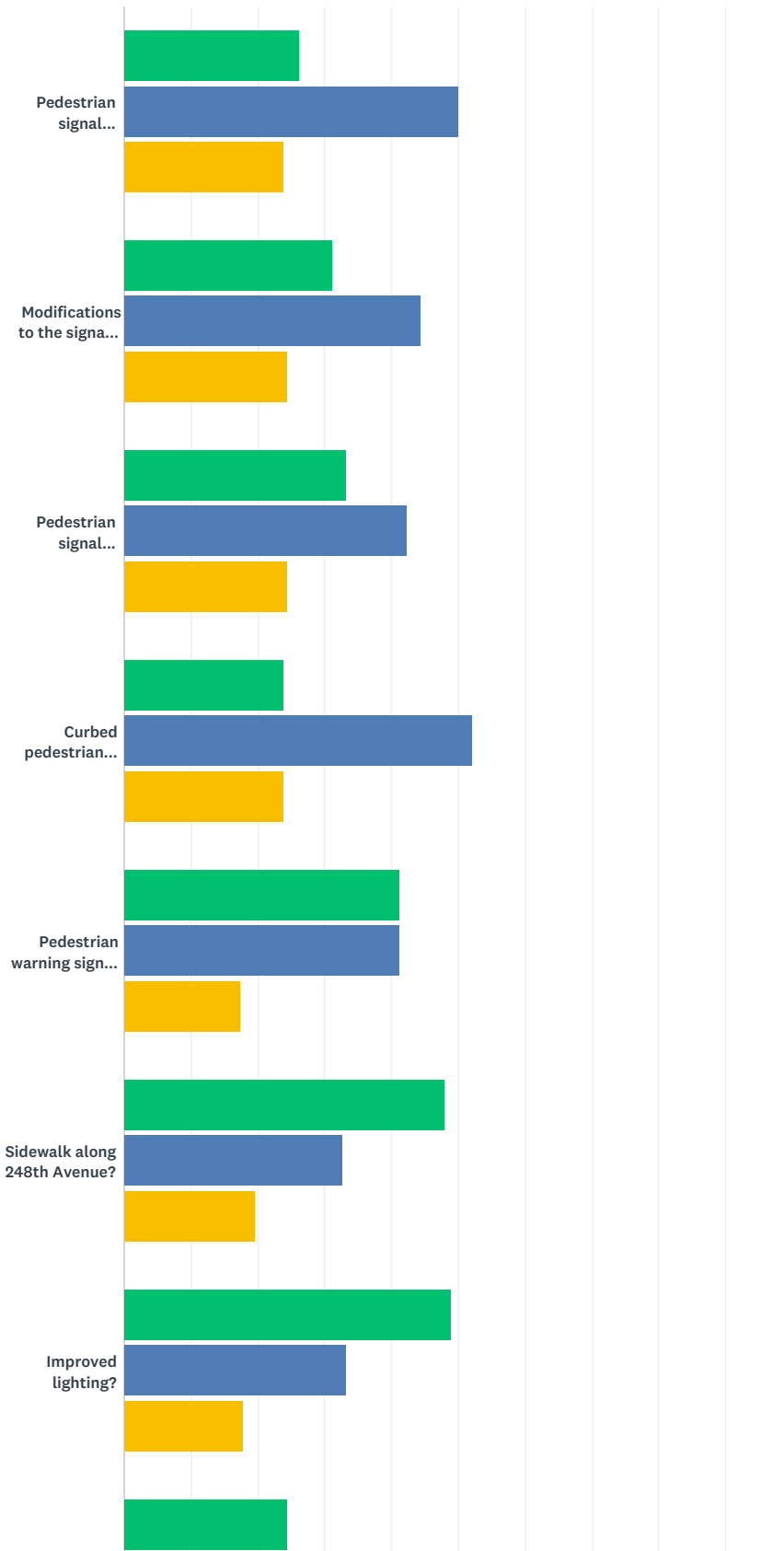

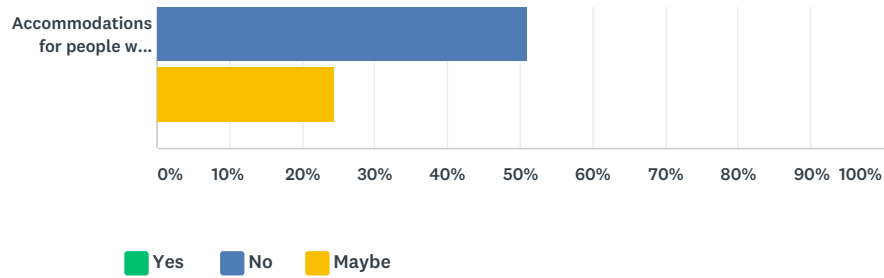

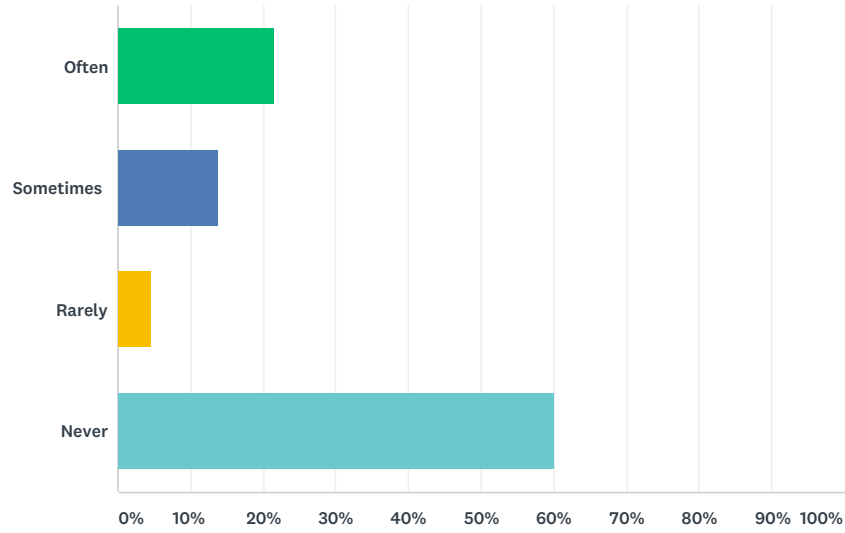

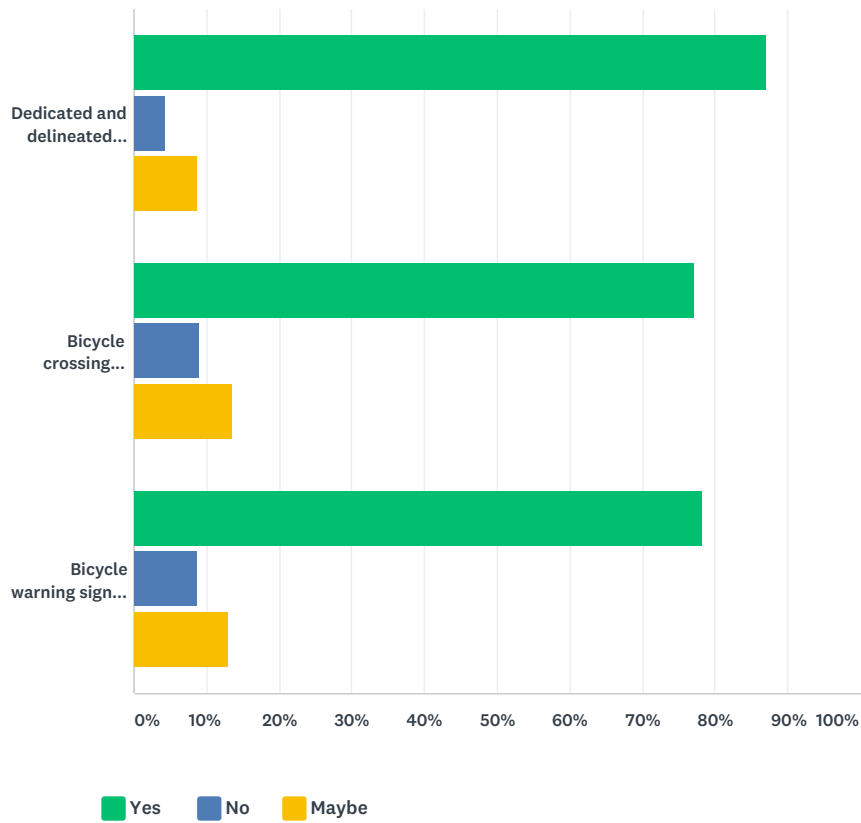

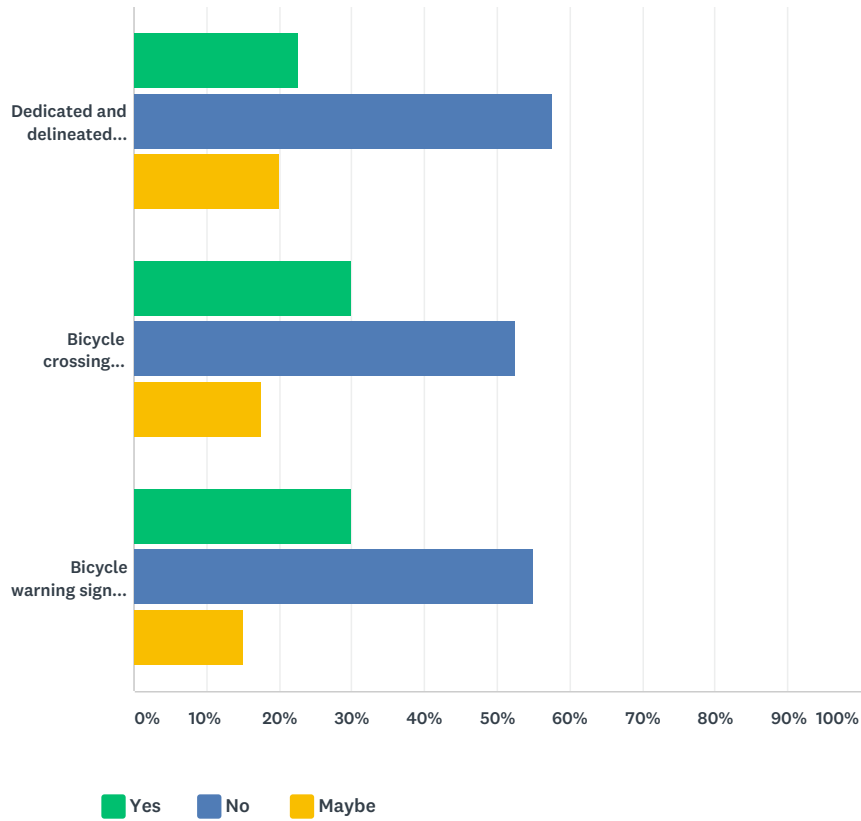

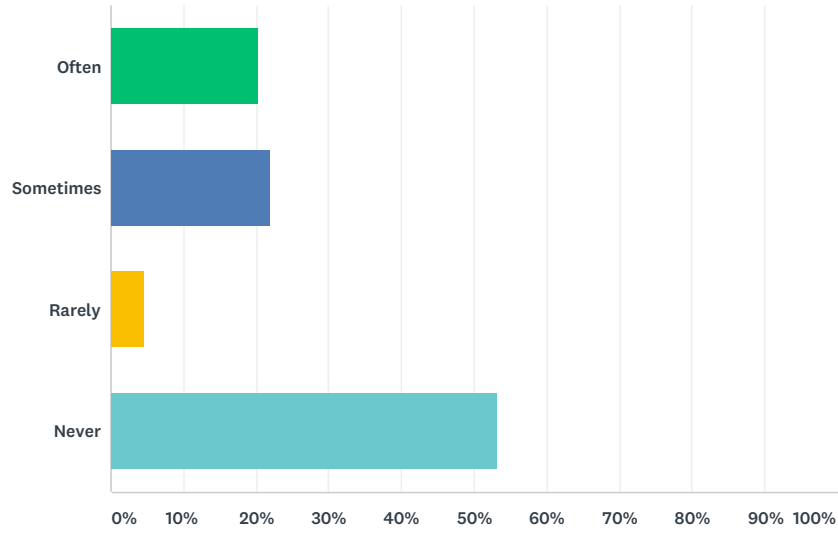

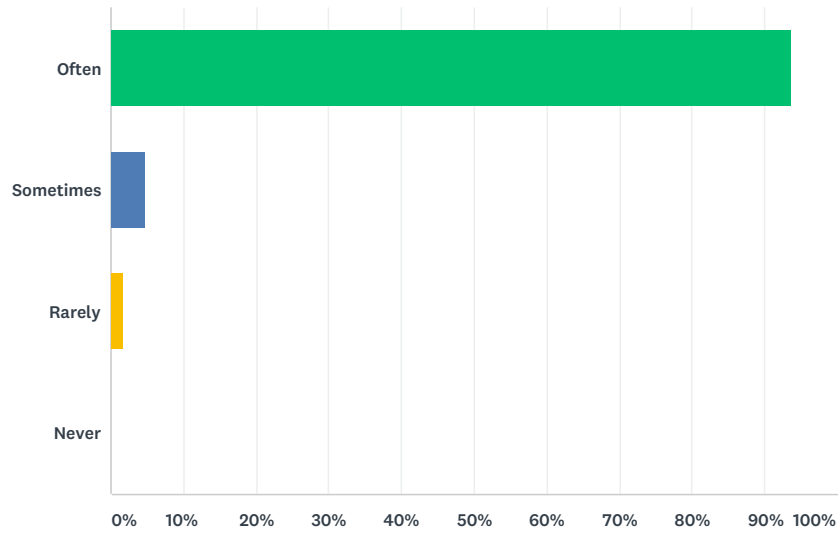

### Q9 Do you ever drive along 248th Avenue?

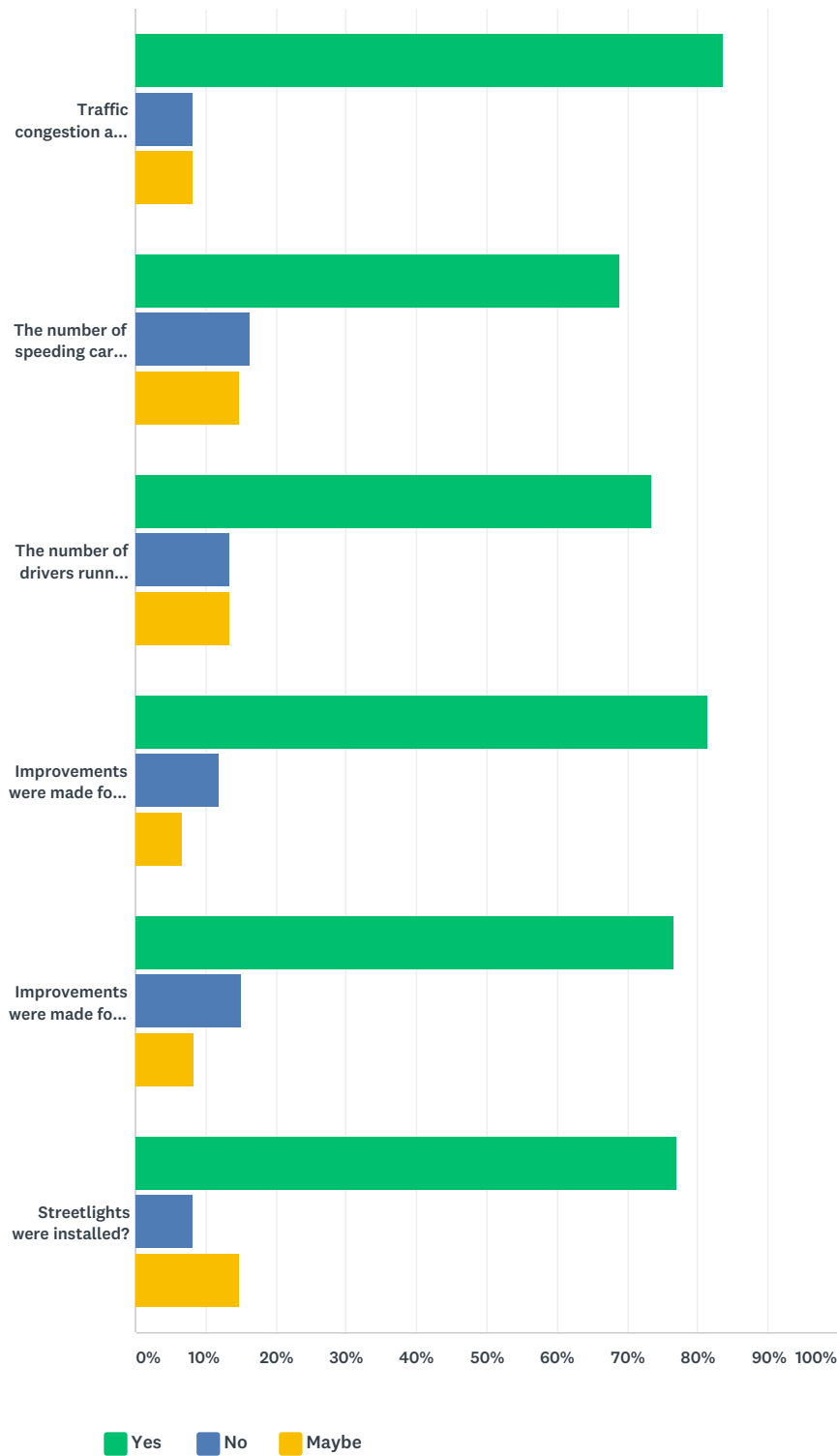

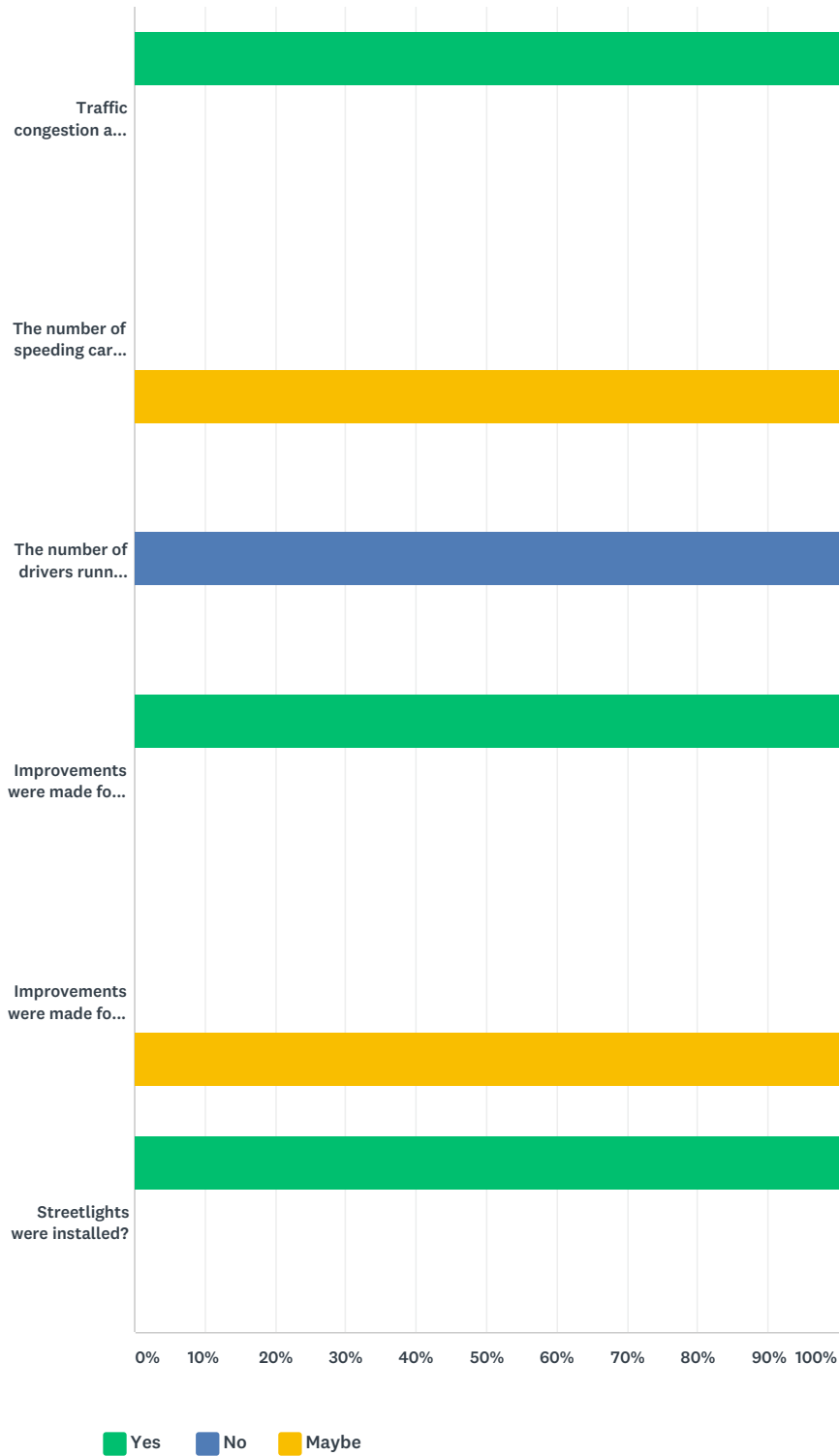

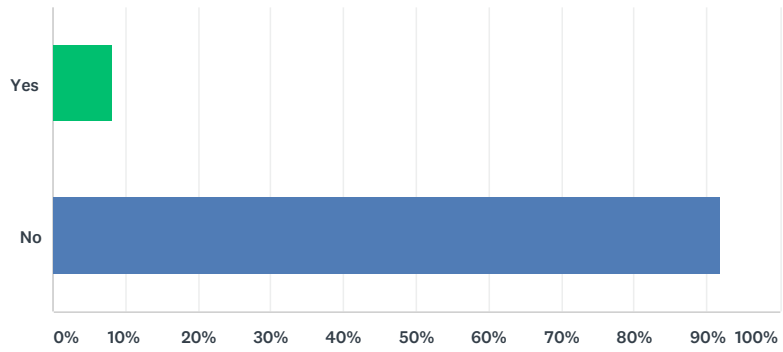

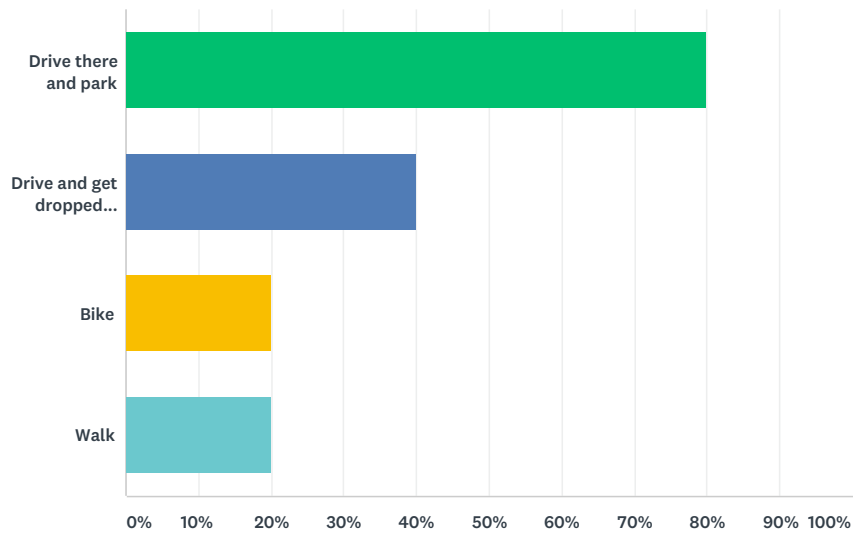

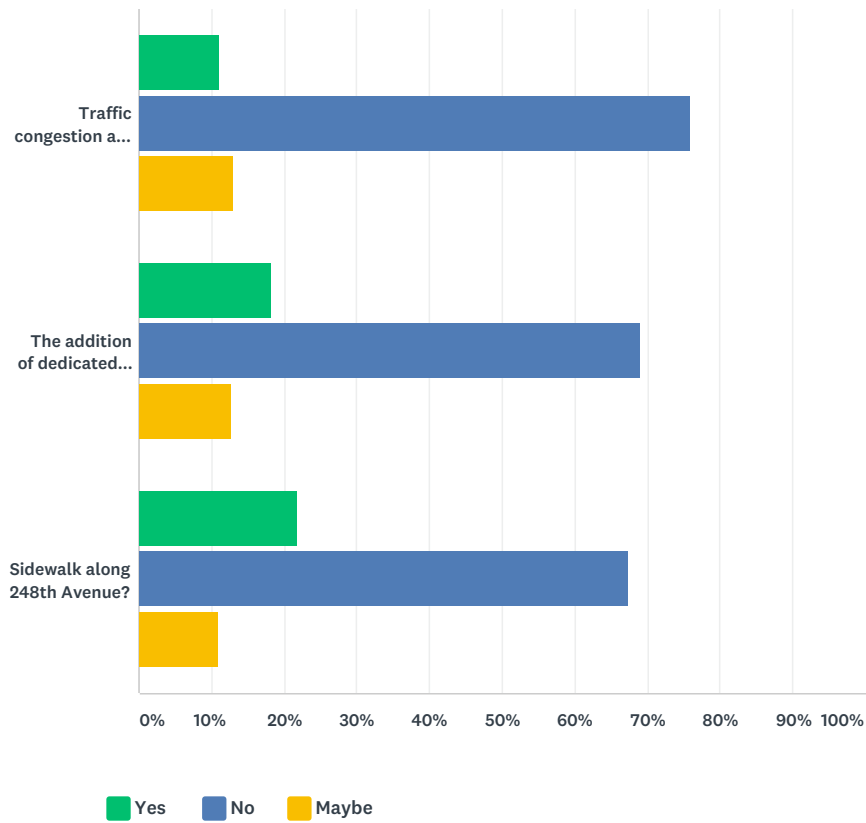
