Per IDOT policy, the goal is to obtain at least a one-third (33%) response rate for each abatement measure location (CNE [Common Noise Environment]). In order for a proposed noise abatement measure to be reasonable based on viewpoints, greater than 50% of the votes received within each CNE must be in favor of the proposed abatement measure. Measures reasonable based on viewpoints are likely to be implemented based on the preliminary design. If it subsequently develops during final design that constraints not foreseen in the preliminary design or public input substantially changes, the abatement measures may need to be modified or removed from the project plans. A final decision on the installation of abatement measures will be made upon completion of the project's final design and the public involvement process.
