



# NAPERVILLE RULES

## What to Know Before You Buy

*Use of e-bikes, e-scooters and other such electric devices in Naperville is regulated by state law and local ordinance.*

### E-Bikes

*Class 1, Class 2 & Class 3 (as defined by state)*

#### Generally allowed on

- Bike Lanes
- Roadways
- Multi-use Paths (Class 1 & 2 only)
- Private Property

*(with permission of the property owner)*

#### Generally NOT allowed on

- Sidewalks
- Riverwalk

#### Important note \*

Dirt bikes and similar off-road vehicles, as well as any device with a motor over 750 watts, are NOT e-bikes and are not allowed on Naperville's public roads, sidewalks, etc.



AGE REQUIREMENT

16+

### E-Scooters

*Maximum motor speed: 10 mph*

#### Generally allowed on

- Bike Lanes
- Roadways (35 mph & under)
- Multi-use Paths
- Private Property

*(with permission of the property owner)*

#### Generally NOT allowed on

- Sidewalks
- Roadways (over 35 mph)
- Riverwalk

#### Important note \*

If it has a motor capable of going faster than 10 mph, it is not allowed on Naperville's public roads, sidewalks, etc.



AGE REQUIREMENT

18+
