TITLE 11, CHAPTER 4

WHAT IS AN E-SCOOTER?

A device weighing less than 100 pounds, with 2 or 3 wheels, handlebars, and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding, that is powered by a motor, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the devices reaches 10 mph.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Front-facing white light
- Rear-facing red reflector or light
- Functioning brakes
- Helmet strongly encouraged

18+

E-SCOOTERS (max motor speed 10 mph)	✗	✓	✗	✓	✗	✓

NOTE:
Scooters with motors capable of sustained speeds exceeding 10 mph without human assistance are prohibited on public streets, sidewalks, paths, etc. in Naperville unless titled and registered as motor vehicles and operated pursuant to state law.

NOTE: E-scooter operators must follow the same rules as traditional bicyclists. This includes yielding at stop signs and traffic signals, riding with traffic, and signaling turns.
