PUBLIC SAFETY ACCREDITATIONS

- Police Department: Internationally accredited 10 times by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). First accredited in 1992 and most recently re-accredited in 2024. Because this process is so rigorous, only 3% of law enforcement agencies nationwide choose to become accredited.
- **Fire Department:** One of only two agencies worldwide to achieve accreditation six consecutive times from the Center for Public Safety Excellence. The department was accredited for the sixth time in 2022.

- AAA (S&P) and Aaa (Moody's) bond rated for almost 30 years reaffirmed in 2025
