PUBLIC SAFETY ACCREDITATIONS

- **Police Department:** Internationally accredited 10 times by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). First accredited in 1992 and most recently reaccredited in 2024. Because this process is so rigorous, only 3% of law enforcement agencies nationwide choose to become accredited.
- **Fire Department:** One of only two agencies worldwide to achieve accreditation six consecutive times from the Center for Public Safety Excellence. The department was accredited for the sixth time in 2022.

- AAA bond rated for 25 years
- Reinvestment of dollars coming into the city from various sectors (retail, restaurants) to help market and attract other businesses
