DESCRIPTION OF GRANT PROGRAM

Each year, the City of Naperville has \$30,000 in matching grant funds available to award to eligible properties for eligible projects (i.e., removal and/or replacement of the existing pole sign from eligible properties), as further described below.

Eligible Property:

- Property must be located along East Ogden Avenue (from Washington Street to the City's eastern boundary).
- Property must currently have a *legal* non-conforming pole sign.

Eligible Projects:

- Each eligible property may receive a 50/50 matching grant from the City to reimburse the applicant up to \$10,000 for costs related to the removal of the existing pole sign, as well as design, construction, and installation of a new commercial monument sign, wall sign, or blade sign (as applicable).
- The City will determine the reimbursement amount for the eligible project; the amount to be reimbursed by the City shall not exceed 50% of the eligible costs based on the lowest cost estimate submitted.

Application, Award, and Reimbursement:

- Eligible projects will be selected by the City on a first-come, first-served basis upon receipt and approval of a completed grant application and all required paperwork, pending availability of grant funds.
- Following City approval of the submitted application, the applicant will be required to obtain all necessary City permits and inspections and complete the eligible project work by November 30th.
- Upon completion of the eligible project work and submittal of the original invoice/bill
 for the completed eligible project work, the City shall reimburse the applicant the
 previously agreed upon reimbursement cost for the eligible project.

Owner Acknowledgment:

By signing below, the applicant acknowledges that the City of Naperville has the right to withhold matching grant funds used for the reimbursement of costs related to the eligible project should the work not be completed within the required timeframe, not be consistent with approved permit drawings, or fail to pass any required City inspection.
