SUBJECT: Overnight Parking Survey

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform the Mayor and City Council about the upcoming public survey on on-street overnight parking.

BACKGROUND

The City of Naperville Municipal Code Section 11-2A-8 restricts on-street parking between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. There are limited exceptions available through the Temporary Overnight Parking Permission and HOA Overnight Parking Program. In recent years, the City has received a growing number of concerns about compliance with the overnight parking ban along with residents seeking relief from the overnight parking restriction.

City Council asked staff during the 4/21/2026 meeting to bring recommendations to a Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) meeting regarding overnight parking options. City staff are seeking resident feedback via an online survey to help inform those recommendations.

DISCUSSION:

The City is using Polco, a civic engagement platform used by local governments, to administer the survey. The feedback from the survey will help City staff better understand community parking needs and guide recommendations for TAB and City Council. While survey results will not be statistically significant, they will provide valuable input to help guide staff's recommendations. The City's Communications Department will promote the survey through the Naperville *Connected* newsletter, City social media, a direct email to approximately 1,475 Polco subscribers who have opted in to receive community surveys, and a dedicated project webpage. The survey will open on August 3 and close on September 18.
