Public Notice: Fire Hydrant Painting Scheduled

Dear Residents,

Please be advised that the City of Naperville will be conducting routine **fire hydrant painting** beginning **Monday, May 18, 2026**, and continuing through the end of **June 2026**, weather permitting.

✂ Purpose: This work ensures hydrants remain visible, compliant with safety standards, and free from corrosion.

📍 Affected Areas: If you have received this notice, your area will be affected during the time frame of this project. **Water Sections D04, D05, L32, N35, W05, W16, W21.**

🎨 Paint Colors: Hydrants will be a variety of colors at any given time representing what stage they are in during the project.

- **Body Colors:**
 - Silver: Bare metal
 - Grey: Primer
 - Orange: Final color

Resident Impact:

- **Please avoid parking near hydrants during this period!**
- Do not touch or tamper with freshly painted hydrants.
- ***Please leave all “WET PAINT” signs where they are, the contractor will remove when completed!!!***
