



# 2025 Year-End Crime and Incident Data

The Naperville Police Department believes that awareness and partnership with our community are essential to maintaining public safety. When residents understand the types of crime occurring in their city, they are better able to practice situational awareness, report suspicious activity, and take simple steps that help prevent crime. For that reason, the Naperville Police Department presents the following overview of crime and incident data reported between Jan. 1 and Dec. 31, 2025.

## Crimes Against Persons

Crimes against persons accounted for approximately one-quarter of the crimes reported in Naperville in 2025. Here are a few takeaways from the 2025 statistics:

- The vast majority (83%) of the reported crimes against persons fell into the category of simple assault. Simple assault includes physical altercations and incidents that don't involve weapons or serious injuries.
- Domestic incidents make up nearly half (47%) of all crimes against persons reported to NPD in 2025. *If you are a victim of domestic violence, please know that help is available. - A total of 26 criminal sexual assaults were reported to police in 2025. While the seriousness of this crime cannot be overstated, it is important for the community to understand that in the majority of these cases, the victim knew or was acquainted with the offender. In six cases, the victim declined to provide information about the incident.

## Crimes Against Property

More than half of Naperville's reported crime in 2025 falls into the property crime category, most of which are theft, fraud (which includes scams and identity theft), and vandalism. Property crime in Naperville dropped in 2025. Here are a few additional takeaways from the 2025 property crimes statistics:

- Financial crimes make up more than a third (35%) of all property crimes reported.
- 19 robberies were reported in 2025.
- Many vehicle burglaries were crimes of opportunity. Approximately 80% involved unlocked vehicles. Residents can significantly reduce their risk by locking their vehicles and removing valuables.
- Less than half (27) of the 63 burglaries reported were residential. The majority (57%) occurred at commercial locations.
- Approximately 1/3 of the 52 motor vehicle thefts documented in 2025 were attempted thefts; 35 vehicles were stolen in 2025.

## Crimes Against Society

Crimes in this category, including drug violations, prostitution, and certain weapons offenses, are often discovered through proactive police work rather than reported by victims. Incidents in this category increased 27% in 2025, largely reflecting increased proactive enforcement by Naperville officers. Drug and narcotics violations increased 36% compared to the previous year.

Naperville remains a safe community thanks to the strong partnership between our residents, businesses, and police department. By staying aware, reporting suspicious activity, and taking simple preventative steps, our community members continue to play a critical role in keeping Naperville safe.


