

2025 Mid-Year Crime and Incident Data

The Naperville Police Department believes that awareness is foundational for overall public safety. Residents who are aware of the types of crimes happening in their city are more likely to practice situational awareness, report suspicious activity to police, and take proactive steps to avoid victimization. For that reason, the Naperville Police Department presents the following overview of crime and incident data reported between Jan. 1 and June 30, 2025.

Crimes Against Persons

Crimes against persons accounted for approximately one-quarter of the crimes reported in Naperville in the first half of 2025. The vast majority (90%) of the reported crimes against persons fell into the categories of intimidation and simple assault. Simple assault includes altercations and incidents (including domestics) that don't involve weapons or serious injuries. Here are a few takeaways from the 2025 mid-year statistics:

- The total number of crimes against persons reported is slightly lower compared to the same time frame last year.
- 14 criminal sexual assaults were reported to police in the first half of 2025. While it does not minimize the seriousness of this crime, we feel it is important for the community to know that all the victims knew or were somehow acquainted with the offender.

Crimes Against Property

More than half of Naperville's reported crime in the first half of 2025 fall into the property crime category, most of which are theft, fraud (which includes scams and identity theft), and vandalism. Here are a few takeaways from the 2025 mid-year statistics:

- Fewer property crimes were reported in the first half of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024
- Financial crimes make up about a quarter (26%) of all property crimes reported.
- 74% of burglaries to vehicles reported in the first half of 2025 involved unlocked vehicles.
- 16 of the 34 burglaries reported were to residences; the remainder were commercial burglaries.
- 13 robberies were reported in the first half of 2025, 5 of which occurred at businesses.

Crimes Against Society

Crimes in this category, such as drug violations and weapons offenses, are often discovered through proactive police work. The first half of 2025 saw a 34% increase in these incidents, signaling enhanced efforts by Naperville officers, particularly in drug enforcement and suppression of illegal activity.
