The **Naperville Senior Task Force (STF)** was established at the direction of the 2014 Naperville City Council to address the unique needs of Naperville's growing senior population:

- 2018 census figures report more than 17,000 Naperville residents are over the age of 65, which accounts for almost 12% of its population. The number of Americans age 65 and older is projected to nearly double from 52 million in 2018 (16% of total population) to 95 million (23% of total population) in 2060.
- The STF works with Mayor Chirico and Councilwoman Patty Gustin is our liaison.
- The STF is composed of nine committed members plus two advisors, all passionately working to enhance the lives of Naperville seniors.

Ongoing Efforts:

- Participate in several health and wellness fairs, including the annual **Healthy, Wealthy and Wise** fair.
- Provide education to seniors through the quarterly newsletter, “**Our Voice**.”
- Provide **free Silver CPR** in collaboration with the Naperville Fire Department, offering 8 classes every year.
- Support **affordable housing** by representing seniors at city council meetings regarding proposals for new housing developments.
- Maintain and distribute a listing of available senior services via the **Naperville Pocket Guide**.

Initiatives:

Senior of the Year award:

Established in 2018, this annual award recognizes male and female seniors. Recipients are recognized by Mayor Chirico at a city council meeting.

Dementia Friendly Naperville:

Worked with the Naperville Fire Department, Naperville Police Department, and numerous community stakeholders to earn this designation in 2020.
