The Naperville Police Department is an internationally-accredited agency that protects and serves the City of Naperville and its nearly 150,000 residents. Our approximately 270-member department is divided into three divisions.

Our **patrol division** responds to calls for service and provides routine patrol and traffic enforcement. The **investigations division** is responsible for conducting follow-up investigations of crimes and implementing community programs. The **administrative services division** is comprised of non-sworn employees in the areas of emergency communications, records, information technology, accreditation and crime analysis.

Together, our mission is to provide extraordinary service to the community while protecting life and property. We live out this mission with an emphasis on integrity, employees, accountability, diversity and community partnership.

Our commitment to collaborating with the entire community is rooted in the tradition of A. George Pradel, a 29-year veteran of NPD and five-term mayor whose devotion to youth and community policing earned him the nickname Officer Friendly.


