SUBJECT: Water Tower West Demolition - Status

BACKGROUND:

On June 18, City Council awarded the bid to demolish and dispose of the former Department of Public Works (DPW) facility located at 414 E. 5th Avenue to McDonagh Demolition.

DISCUSSION:

McDonagh Demolition is clearing the site of the remaining debris this week and is scheduled to have all equipment off site by August 20th.

The Department of Public Works and TED Business Group are partnered to begin work on Phase 2, the paving and striping plans for the proposed parking area. Survey work will start the week of August 19th. Weather depending, staff anticipates the daily fee commuter lot will be open for use in late October.
