SUBJECT: Traffic Calming Toolkit Public Comments

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform the Mayor and City Council that public feedback is being requested regarding a citywide Traffic Calming Toolkit.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Naperville is developing a Traffic Calming Toolkit to address vehicle speeds and volumes within residential areas. Traffic Calming is a collection of measures used to support the livability and vitality of residential neighborhoods through a reduction in vehicle speed and/or volumes. A Traffic Calming Toolkit will provide Naperville with a consistent, data driven approach to address resident requests.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Naperville is providing the public with the preliminary Traffic Calming Toolkit that has been developed by our consultant Kenig, Lindgren, O'Hara, Aboona, Inc. (KLOA). City staff is requesting public feedback to determine any modifications or alterations that may be needed to better serve the community. Residents have until Wednesday, September 30, 2020 to provide feedback. Public feedback and the final Traffic Calming Toolkit will be presented to the Transportation Advisory Board and City Council later this year.
