SUBJECT: West Street Roadway Reconstruction Begins Week of Aug. 7

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the City Council with information about the upcoming West Street roadway reconstruction project.

BACKGROUND

As part of the City's 2023 Street Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program, City contractor K-Five Construction will reconstruct West Street between Emerald Drive and Rickert Drive starting the week of Aug. 7. Work will take place in two phases to minimize impacts and decrease the overall construction timeline. Pending weather and unforeseen circumstances, work is expected to be complete and all lanes reopened by the end of September.

All impacted businesses and residents in the area of Emerald Drive, Mobile Court, Williamsburg Drive, Savannah Circle, Merrimac Circle, Gartner Road, Plainfield/Naperville Road and the Hobson Plaza shopping center received notification of the project and a letter with project details the week of July 31.

DISCUSSION

Construction includes the removal and replacement of the roadway pavement and subgrade. During the first phase, crews will reconstruct the northbound side of the road, moving north and southbound traffic to the southbound side. Once complete, crews will reconstruct the southbound side of the roadway and all traffic will relocate temporarily to the northbound side. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times.

Traffic control devices will be in place to direct motorists; drivers are being asked to allow additional travel time if visiting this area or use alternate routes.

Every effort will be made to ensure at least one access point to all impacted neighborhoods will be maintained; however, there may be short periods of time when neighborhoods with one access point will be inaccessible. This work will be done midday to provide the least

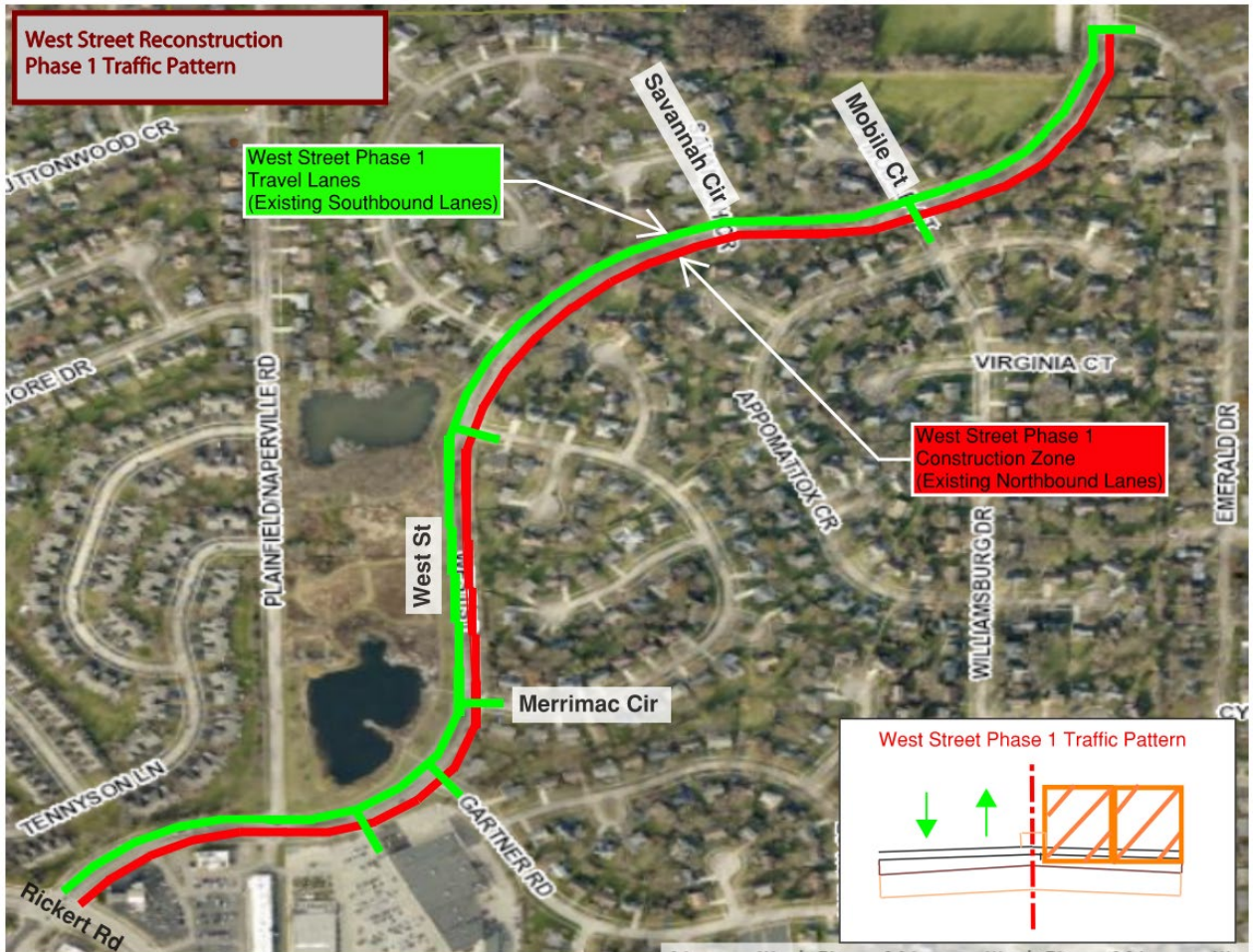
amount of inconvenience to residents. Mail delivery, curbside garbage and recycling services and emergency services will not be impacted. TED is working with other city departments to ensure service continuation to residents and is working with the Communications Division on needed communications to the area.

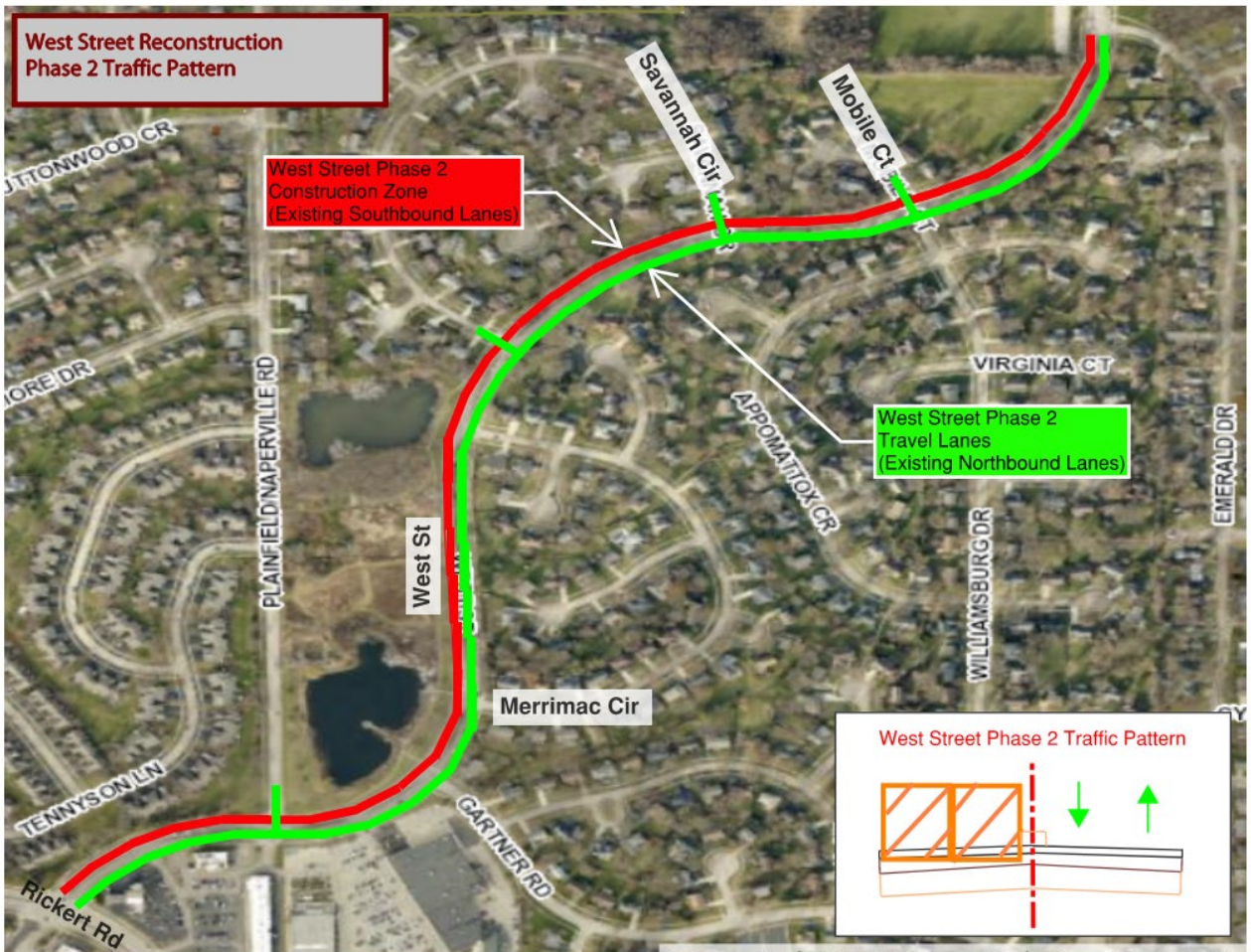

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify residents of the new Sustainability Open Data page.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The City of Naperville has released a newly updated Sustainability Open Data page to track progress on the Sustainability Work Plan, which was approved by City Council in August 2021.

The Sustainability Team collaborated with a Project Manager in the Department of Public Works to identify datasets that align with key areas of the Sustainability Work Plan, including Natural Resources, Waste, and Transportation.

The project team also worked across all City departments to gather sustainability data on municipal operations and initiatives.

The new Sustainability Open Data page combines data analysis with storytelling to provide transparency around Naperville's progress on its sustainability commitments and will be regularly updated to track the City's sustainability journey.
