BILL SUMMARY

<u>SB1937, House Amendment 1 – PENSIONS ALTERNATIVE ANNUITY</u> On May 27, House Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 1937 was introduced. The bill would enhance Tier 2 Police, Fire and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) pensions.

SB243, House Amendment 1- OMA and FOIA changes

FOIA submissions must contain the full request in the body of the request (no links or attachments to address cybersecurity concerns), addresses processes for FOIA requests not generated by a person, removes requirement for physical posting of the description of the local government entity and allows for posting on the website.

Neither bill successfully passed both houses in spring session.
