#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform the Mayor and City Council of the teen art submissions that have been chosen to wrap Naperville streetlight controller boxes.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Earlier this spring, the Community Services Department conducted a Call for Teen Artists asking Naperville high school students to submit artwork to be showcased on six streetlight controller boxes. The City received 30 entries, and members of Naperville's ArtForum made the final selections. The artwork will be installed by June 30, 2025.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The City is proud to announce the six artists whose submissions have been selected to wrap streetlight controller boxes located near Naperville North and Naperville Central high schools:
