Labor Day City Closures

In recognition of Labor Day, on Monday, Sept. 7:

- Non-emergency City offices will be closed.
- There will be no curbside garbage, recycling or yard waste collection on Labor Day. Collection will take place one day later than usual that week.
- The Electronics Recycling Center will be closed.

Overnight Parking Survey

The City is collecting feedback regarding overnight parking, which is currently prohibited on City streets from 2 a.m. until 5 a.m., with some exceptions. Community input will help City staff better understand community parking needs and will guide decisions on local traffic and parking policies.

Thanks to all who participated in the 2026 National Community Survey. The survey captured resident feedback about City services and the overall quality of life in Naperville. Polco, a social science firm specializing in gathering and analyzing information for public sector entities, conducted the survey. U.S. Small Business Administration Severe Weather Disaster Loans

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) recently issued a disaster declaration for the June 10-11, 2026, severe weather that impacted Chicagoland. This declaration allows Naperville homeowners and renters to apply for SBA home disaster loans to help cover losses to real estate and personal property not fully covered by insurance.

A Safer Naper: Back-to-School Safety

As students of all ages return to school, the Naperville Police Department reminds families of these important safety tips:



- **Preschool & Kindergarten:** Children should be able to recite their address and a caregiver cell phone number. They should walk to and from school with an adult or group and know their bus number.
- **Elementary, Middle & High School:** Students should use the buddy system and practice a school route from naperville.il.us/SchoolWalkRoutes. If children feel afraid or uncomfortable, they should say NO, GO and TELL a trusted adult. Children should check before going anywhere and never leave school with anyone unapproved. Once home, they should lock the door and contact a trusted adult by phone or text.
- **College:** Caregivers should review personal safety guidelines, consider discussing scenarios to help their child understand the possible consequences of their actions, and take inventory of valuables and electronic devices in case of loss or theft.
