

## Fall 2020 City of Naperville Parkway Tree Selection

### **MIYABE MAPLE** – *Acer miyabei*

Size: 40' tall by 25' wide.

Growth Rate: Fast

Leaf Color: Dark green turning yellow in fall.

Notes: Oval to round shape, corky bark, native to Japan. Pest resistant and urban tolerant.

### **JAPANESE TREE LILAC** - *Syringa reticulata*

Size: 25' tall by 15' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium

Leaf Color: Dark green in summer turning yellow/brown in fall

Notes: Small ornamental tree native to Japan. Plumes of creamy white flowers in summer. Attractive reddish-brown bark.

### **KENTUCKY COFFEE TREE** – *Gymnocladus dioica*

Size: 65' tall x 50' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium

Leaf Color: Dark bluish green in summer and yellow in fall.

Notes: Native to Illinois, very few disease or insect problems, tolerates tough urban conditions.

### **HACKBERRY**- *Celtis occidentalis*

Size: 60' tall x 40' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium

Leaf Color: Green leaves turn yellow in fall.

Notes: Native to Illinois, unique warty bark, adaptable to tough urban conditions.

### **HYBRID ELM** - *Ulmus species*

Size: 70' tall by 50' wide.

Growth Rate: Fast

Leaf Color: Dark green in summer turning yellow in fall.

Notes: Tolerant of urban conditions, including poor soils, salt and pollution.

### **RED MAPLE** – *Acer rubrum*

Size: 50' tall by 40' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium to fast.

Leaf Color: Dark green in summer, fall color varies from yellow to orange to red.

Notes: Native to Illinois, red flowers in early spring.

**SILVER LINDEN** – *Tilia tomentosa*

Size: 50' tall by 30' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium

Leaf Color: Dark green upper surface with silver color beneath, turning yellow in fall.

Notes: One of the best lawn and street trees, tolerates heat and drought.

**FREEMAN MAPLE** – *Acer freemanii*

Size: 60' tall by 35' wide.

Growth Rate: Fast

Leaf Color: Green leaves turn red in fall. May have tints of orange and yellow.

Notes: Excellent for parkways and as a large shade tree.

**BUR OAK** – *Quercus macrocarpa*

Size: 80' tall by 60' wide.

Growth Rate: Slow at first then medium

Leaf Color: Green leaves turn yellow to brown in fall.

Notes: Native to Illinois, long lived large shade tree.

**SWAMP WHITE OAK** – *Quercus bicolor*

Size: 60' tall by 60' wide.

Growth Rate: Medium

Leaf Color: Dark glossy leaves turn yellow to brown in fall.

Notes: Native to Illinois, tolerates urban conditions well.
