

Naperville City Hall Planting – Pollinator Garden



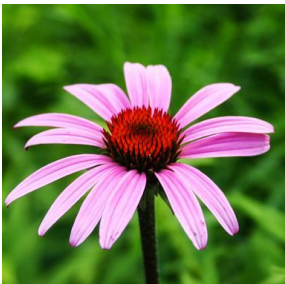
Shooting Star, Dodecatheon meadia

Full or partial shade,
Moist soil
Blooms in mid spring from May to June, white to pink
2 to 16 inches high



Foxglove, Penstemon digitalis

Full sun to average Shade
Average to moist
Blooms May – June, white
30 to 48 inches high



Purple Coneflower, Echinacea purpurea

Full sun to partial share
Dry or Moist
Blooms mid-summer to early fall, pink
24-30 inches high



Prairie Coreopsis, Coreopsis palmata (savannah variety)

Full sun
Dry or moist
Blooms July-August, yellow
24 inches high



Butterfly Weed, Asclepias tuberosa

Sun
Dry
Blooms June, July & August
24-36 inches high



Purple Prairie Coneflower – Dalea purpurea

Sun
Dry
Blooms July & August
24-36 inches high



Prairie Dropseed, Sporobolus heterolepis

Sun
Moist to Dry
Late summer blooms
24-30 inches high



Wild Blue Indigo, Baptisia australis

Sun
Moist
Blooms May-July, Blue
48 inches



Mountain Mint, Pycnanthemum virginianum

Full or partial sun
Moist to average
Blooms June – Sept., white
36 inches



Rough Blazing Star, Liatris aspera

Sun
Dry
Blooms August & September
24-36 inches high



Cylindrical Blazing Star, *Liatris cylindracea*,

Sun
Dry
Blooms July-October
12 inches high



Wild Bergamot, *Monarda fistulosa*

Sun & partial shade
Moist/well drained
Blooms July, August & September
3-4 ft. high



Black Eyed Susan, *Rudbeckia hirta*,

Sun
Dry
Blooms July, August September
18-24 inches high



Asclepias incarnate, Swamp Milkweed

Sun & partial shade
Moist to wet
Blooms June-August
4 ft. high
